ITINERARY

DAY 1. TUESDAY, JULY 8. ARRIVAL TRANSFER

Reception at the international airport of Mexico City "Benito Juárez" transfer to your hotel.

DAY 2. WEDNESDAY, JULY 9. HOT AIR BALLOON TOUR IN LAS PIRÁMIDES DE TEOTIHUACAN FROM MÉXICO CITY. Breakfast.

Leaving Mexico City, enjoy the wonderful aesthetics of the Pyramids of the Sun and the Moon are seen from a different angle. The activity begins early in the morning when, after introductions and some instructions are given, we will all participate in filling the balloon with air, a magical experience. We will fly for approximately one hour and the itinerary will be shown by the wind, which commands our journey. From there we will continue to the archaeological zone of Teotihuacan with our entrance and guide, where we will see the monumental pyramids of the Sun and the Moon, the temple of Quetzalpapalotl and the Causeway of the Dead. We will also visit a craft center, where they will give us an explanation about the production of crafts and drinks traditional (Includes tasting of Tequila, Mezcal and Pulque). Lunch at Gran Teocalli. Upon returning to the city, we will visit the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of America. Return to the hotel and rest of the day at leisure.

DAY 3. THURSDAY, JULY 10. MEXICO CITY / QUERETARO / SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE

Visit to the city of Querétaro, cultural heritage of humanity, where we will visit the Aqueduct, the Ex Convento de la Cruz and the Historical Center. We will continue road to San Miguel de Allende, to get to know this peaceful newly named city cultural heritage of humanity, where the great comedian Cantinflas and residence of artists and intellectuals. The Parish of San Miguel stands out as points of interest Arcángel, the Convent of La Concepción, the Church of San Francisco and the Allende Institute. It has a wide variety of craft stores, cafes and restaurants. Accommodation.

DAY 04. FRIDAY, JULY 11. SAN MIGUEL DE ALLENDE / DOLORES HIDALGO / GUANAJUATO Breakfast.



Departure to Dolores Hidalgo, where in 1810 the priest Don Miguel Hidalgo gave the famous scream of the beginning of the Mexican War of Independence. There is the house-museum of this national hero and is also the birthplace of the famous composer José Alfredo Jiménez. Continuation to Guanajuato, cultural heritage city of humanity, annual headquarters of the International Cervantino Festival. In the afternoon We will enjoy getting to know this beautiful city, full of alleys and squares, which offers us places as interesting as the University, the Juárez Theater, the Calle del Beso, the house-museum of the muralist Diego Rivera, husband of Frida Kahlo. Its streets and underground avenues are unique in the country, the house of Jorge Negrete, the Don Quixote Museum and his famous Mummies Museum. Accommodation.

DAY 05. SATURDAY, JULY 12. GUANAJUATO / MEXICO CITY

DAY 06. SUNDAY, JULY 13. FRIDA KAHLO MUSEUM, COYOACÁN PANORAMIC AND XOCHIMILCO FROM CDMX

In Mexico City we will begin our visit in Xochimilco, Heritage of Humanity, where we will ride in an Aztec boat. panoramic view of the wonderful neighborhood of Coyoacán, its 16th century mansions and the church of San Juan Bautista. In the same neighborhood We will visit the Frida Kahlo Museum, known as "The Blue House," where the most recognized Latin American artist worldwide.

DAY 07. MONDAY, JULY 14. PUEBLA AND MAGICAL TOWN CHOLULA Breakfast.

Leaving Mexico City, we will visit Santa María Tonantzintla and San Francisco Acatepec where you will discover its beautiful Indigenous Baroque churches. Afterwards we will admire the largest pyramid in the world in the archaeological zone of Cholula, and its 365 Churches; We will continue to Puebla, a World Heritage City declared by UNESCO, visiting its imposing Cathedral in its main square, the chapel del Rosario, considered the eighth wonder of the art world.
